

The importance of del nido cardioplegia solution in coronary artery bypass surgery

We read with interest the article by Algarni¹ published entitled "Routine use of del Nido cardioplegia compared with blood cardioplegia in all types of adult cardiac surgery procedures." In this study, Del Nido cardioplegia group has shorter aortic cross-clamp time for coronary artery bypass graft patients. But there is no sufficient data about the number of distal anastomosis between cardioplegia groups. If there is a significant difference between groups, this answer can change the aortic cross-clamp times regardless of cardioplegia.
